<p>Mission of Role</p>	<p>VOICE is a cutting-edge, for impact-non-profit, that is revolutionizing the conflict, crisis and disaster response landscape by harnessing the power of women and girls. The mission of this role is to lead VOICE’s domestic work on addressing violence against women and girls (VAWG) and in particular marginalized communities such as Black, Indigenous and People of Color (BIPOC), migrant and refugee populations, and other groups living on the margins in the US - including US territories and tribal lands. This position will lead efforts to create and strengthen a network of women and girl leaders to transform outdated disaster and emergency response systems and build innovative solutions to VAWG during the COVID-19 pandemic and well beyond. This position will focus on envisioning and building VOICE’s US portfolio.</p>
